

Entering Quilts in the 2017 Hauptstrasse Quiltfest Outdoor Show

Registration Deadline: May 4th

After May 4th we are unable to accommodate changes to your registrations except to eliminate a quilt that is already registered. You will receive a receipt when your drop off your quilt. Online entries will receive an electronic receipt by email.

Each quilt entry requires a Registration Form, Quilt ID Tag & Photo of the finished quilt. Photos should be submitted with the quilt at the time of drop off. Photos can be printed off of a color printer at home an actual "photograph" is not required. **We will not accept quilts without a photo.**

Definition of a quilt for our Show:

A quilt is two layers of fabric with a filling that is stitched together with lines or a pattern. Quilting may be done by hand or by machine. Quilts do not need to have a sleeve for our show.

Size:

We cannot accept stuffed animals, tablecloths, pillow shams or other non-quilt items. Shapes other than squares and rectangles are discouraged and may not be displayed due to difficulty in hanging in our show.

For Entering Multiple Quilt Registration:

After entering the first quilt, on the "Thank You" page, under Explore select "Search Activities". In the Red Box make sure to check "ignore conflict".

General Registration:

Please use the document titled "Quilt Registration".

Sale Quilts:

Quilts entered for sale must adhere to copyright law. Please use the document titled "Quilt Sales Registration". Boerne Parks & Recreation will handle all sales and will retain a 15% commission. Sales Tax will be collected at the time of sale and will be remitted by the City. Checks will be processed and mailed within 2 weeks of the show for any quilts sold.

Special Exhibits:

Please indicate on your registration form if you intend for your quilt to hang in the following exhibits.

Patriotic Quilts- Should include an "Americana" theme; include a color palette of red, white & blue etc.

Modern Quilts- Should adhere to the AMQG standards of a "Modern Quilts"-Refer to the following website for those standards. <http://www.themodernquiltguild.com/about> Quilts that do not fit this standard will be hung in the general display.

Antique Quilts- Should be 50+ years old and be a twin size or larger. Please no lap or baby quilts.

In the Garden Challenge- For those who have already agreed to the Challenge and are providing the Focus Fabric.

Liability Release:

Quilts in the show are hung outdoors. Each exhibitor must sign a Release Agreement included in the paper registration or online registration. An adult is required to sign the release for any entrant under the age of 18.

Photography:

Quilts may be photographed by show attendees and the media. Submission of a quilt constitutes permission by the quilter/owner for it to be photographed. The City of Boerne may use images of any quilt submitted for promotional purposes.

Boerne Parks & Recreation reserves the right not to display quilts that do not meet the Entry Criteria & Requirements.

SALE AGREEMENT

The City of Boerne, will be responsible for collecting and remitting sales taxes to the state. The City of Boerne will take all payments for quilts including sales tax at the event.
