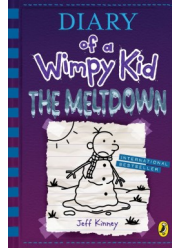

End-of-Summer Blues Concert: Blues Guitarist Michael Dyson Friday, September 14, 6pm

Kid-sized blues comes to Boerne! Known to his many fans as Mr. Blue Shoes, Michael Dyson is a Grammy-Award winning producer, youth entertainer, guitarist and performer. To date, Mr. Dyson has shared his unique version of the Blues story with over 240,000 children. Michael co-founded The Blue Shoes Project, a nonprofit organization dedicated to introducing young audiences to living Blues Legends.

As Mr. Dyson explains, his Mr. Blue Shoes show is a one hour, highly interactive and engaging, multi-sensory live music experience that combines Blues music, oral history and life lessons, designed to inspire children of all ages about music and learning.
