TAKE NOTICE that the City of Boerne, Texas, submitted an application to the Department of Justice for pre-clearance, pursuant to the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended, of the Adoption of a change from the Cumulative Voting System to the Creation of Five (5) Single Member Districts, City of Boerne, Texas City Council approved the plan on December 2, 2009.


Pursuant to the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended, 42 U.S.C. 1973, and 28 C.F.R. Part 51, City of Boerne, Texas filed a Voting Rights Submission with the Department of Justice for preclearance of the above referenced voting system dated January 6, 2010.
