

## **IMPORTANT ELECTION UPDATE**

In response to the global Coronavirus pandemic, Texas Governor Gregg Abbott issued a proclamation suspending certain provisions of the Texas Election Code to allow all local political subdivisions utilizing the May 2, 2020 uniform election date to postpone their election to the November 3, 2020 uniform election date.

At the March 24, 2020, City Council Meeting, City Council voted to postpone the Boerne General Election to November 3, 2020. In addition, City Council approved the following guidelines required by the State:

- Candidate filings for the Municipal election for May 2, 2020 for the City of Boerne, Texas, for the purpose of electing a City Council Member for District 3 shall remain valid for the election to be held on November 3, 2020, and that the filing period for candidates will not be re-opened for the election to be held on November 3, 2020.
- All annual applications for ballot by mail (ABBM) for voters that are voting by mail due to being over the age of 65 or due to disability will still be valid for the November 3, 2020, election; and that ABBMs for voters who submitted ABBMs based on expected absence from the county shall not be valid for the postponed November 3, 2020 election.
- The voter registration deadline for the November 3, 2020, election is October 5, 2020, the deadline to submit an ABBM is October 23, 2020, and the dates for early voting are October 19, 2020 through October 30, 2020

## **May 2, 2020 General Election - POSTPONED**

The next General Election will be on Saturday, May 2, 2020, at the new City Hall located at 447 N. Main Street, Boerne, TX 78006. The first day to file for a place on the ballot was January 15, 2020; the last day to file an application for a place on the ballot was February 14, 2020.

Early Voting by personal appearance will be conducted each weekday at the Kendall County Elections Office located at 221 Fawn Valley Drive, Boerne, TX beginning Monday, April 20, 2020. The last day of Early Voting is Tuesday, April 28, 2020.

## **November 3, 2020 General Election**

The next General Election will be on Tuesday, November 3, 2020 at the new City Hall located at 447 N. Main Street, Boerne, TX 78006. Early Voting by personal appearance will be conducted each weekday at the Kendall County Elections Office located at 221 Fawn Valley Drive, Boerne, TX beginning October 19, 2020 through October 30, 2020.
