This will extend the City Council and Mayor's terms from 2 years to 3 years.

Clarifies the timing of the election of a Mayor Pro Tem by City Council and filling a vacancy of the Mayor Pro Tem office

Proposition H

This update will allow our rules and regulations to be in accordance with state law.

Will require that tie votes for municipal office be resolved in compliance with the constitution and state elections law.

Clarifies that a Council Member must live in the elected District during their entire term of office.
