

# December 2020 – Boerne Fire Department Monthly Report

- The Boerne Fire Department responded to 143 incidents for the month of December 2020, compared to 138 incidents in December 2019. Firefighters responded to 1393 incidents for the year.
- Fire Department members spent a total of 237.95 man hours responding to incidents within the City limits and 232.40 man hours responding to incidents outside the City limits, for a total of 470.35 hours.
- Personnel spent 168.57 hours in training sessions and 25.5 hours in departmental meetings held by Zoom during the month of December 2020 .
- Fire Department members have spent a total of 8315.45 hours since January 1, 2020 responding to incidents, attending meetings, attending training sessions and participating in extra activities.
