

JUNE 2021 – BOERNE FIRE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT

- The Boerne Fire Department responded to 156 incidents for the month of June 2021, compared to 109 incidents in June 2020. Firefighters have responded to 1058 incidents so far this year.
- Firefighters spent 259.91 man hours responding to incidents inside the City limits and 159.73 man hours responding to incidents outside the City limits, for a total of 419.64 hours responding to incidents in June 2021.
- Firefighters spent 24 hours in meetings and 141 hours in training session in June 2021. Personnel also spent 30 hours participating in the Boerne Vaternags Parade.
- Firefighters have spent a total of 4900.82 hours since January 1, 2021 responding to incidents, attending meetings / training sessions, and participating in extra activities.
