City of Boerne to host regional COVID-19 vaccination hub

After weeks of work between the city of Boerne and other partners across Kendall County, the Texas Department of State Health Services has approved Boerne’s application to be a COVID-19 vaccination hub and we are hosting our first event this week.

“This has been a tremendous undertaking,” Mayor Tim Handren said. “I am proud of the work the city staff and I have done to bring this to fruition in getting the COVID-19 vaccine to Boerne as a public-facing program.”

Starting at 9 a.m. on Feb. 9, 2021, those interested in receiving the COVID-19 vaccine can register online for the city of Boerne’s first vaccination hub.

A link to the registration forms will be posted on the city’s website and will have the option to switch to Spanish translation.

DSHS has committed to providing 500 doses of the Moderna vaccines to the city and Kendall County. Please note, we anticipate all available appointments on Friday will be filled in a matter of minutes.

The vaccination site will not be open to people without appointments and will not offer on-site registration. The mayor also stresses the need for family and friends to help those who might be tech savvy.

“If you have parents or grandparents who might need help technologically, to get registered, and if you can help them at 9 o’clock that would be great,” Handren said.

The city will be scheduling appointments to those who are qualified to receive the vaccine in accordance with Department of State Health Services Phases 1A and 1B.

In partnership with St. Peter the Apostle Catholic Church, the city will be utilizing the parish’s 9,000 square foot Cana Ballroom to provide the vaccine to the public.

The vaccination site will be open Wednesday.

Once a reservation is confirmed, people will receive a follow up email with appointment information.

We ask that people not show up more than 15 minutes before their scheduled time.
