Meeting Summary

The meeting was to discuss multiple projects, some will be at the December Planning and Zoning Commission meeting, but this project won't. The applicant requested an early BOND meeting to have time to see how the community would react to the request and have time to make changes as needed.

The property is currently outside the city limits and has requested annexation. With the annexation process, the area will be zoned. The applicant will have different routes to accomplish the proposed development, and they will all be decided before the item is added to a P&Z agenda.

The property under consideration is located on the west side of IH-10 on the access road, north of Frederick Creek. The area close to the creek won't be disturbed and will be dedicated to the city. The development will have to comply with all the city regulations for dark sky preservation, drainage, LID and water quality. The proposed development is a multi-family complex totaling 192 units with 1, 2, or 3 bedrooms. The building will be 3 stories, garden-style, with a high-quality mix material. The interior of the units will have solid surface countertops, stainless steel appliances, an in-unit washer and dryer. The company building the development has a business model to rent all the units. The complex will have multiple amenities such as outdoor playing areas, walking trails, clubhouse, fitness center, pool. The project has received a letter of support for a TDHCA from the City Council during the 12 October meeting.
