Police investigating fatal rollover crash on I-10

The Boerne Police are investigating a fatal crash that occurred Monday afternoon.

On March 28, at 2:13 p.m., police were dispatched to a single vehicle rollover crash on eastbound Interstate 10 near mile marker 539.

A preliminary investigation shows the driver of a black SUV lost control of the vehicle and overcorrected, causing the SUV to roll multiple times.

There were four people inside the vehicle, an adult female driver, an infant, a 2-year-old child and a 4-year-old child.

All three children were ejected, and the preliminary investigations shows they may not have been properly restrained in their child safety seats.

Precinct 1 Justice of the Peace Michelle Van Stavern pronounced the 4-year-old deceased at the scene.

The three other victims were taken to University Hospital in San Antonio for treatment.

Next of kin has not been notified.

This is Boerne's second traffic fatality in 2022.

UPDATE #1 – MARCH 29, 2022

The family involved is from Foley, Alabama.

The three victims transported to University Hospital continue to recover and should be released in the coming days.

The investigation continues to show that the children were not restrained in their car seats, and the car seats were not properly secured to the frame of the SUV.

Please note that the Boerne Police Department offers a free car seat inspection. Residents can call 830-249-8645 to schedule an appointment with an officer who is certified as a child passenger safety (CPS) technician.

UPDATE #2 – APRIL 1, 2022

The Boerne Police Department continues to conduct its investigation into the fatality crash that occurred where three children were ejected after the vehicle rolled along I-10 East near mile maker 539.

One of the children, Star Adams, 4, died at the scene. Two other children, along with their mother who was driving the vehicle, were transported to University Hospital in San Antonio.

After reviewing the evidence, three warrants of arrest were issued for Kianna Adams, 27, of Foley, Alabama on charges of:

- Manslaughter, 2nd degree felony
- Injury to a child causing serious bodily injury, 1st degree felony
- Injury to a child causing bodily injury, 3rd degree felony

Adams was arrested on March 31, 2022, in San Antonio by Texas DPS and remains in the Bexar County Jail on bonds totaling \$225,000.
