Before you dig – Make the Call!

The leading cause of pipeline damage is the failure to call and obtain information regarding the pipeline's location. Damage to an underground water, sewer, gas or electric pipeline, as seemingly as insignificant as a scratch or a dent, can cause a leak.

State law requires that you contact a state one call center before beginning excavation on your property. The process is as simple as dialing 811 from your home phone or your cell phone – you will be connected with a state one call center. The one call center will notify the City of Boerne to locate city owned underground utilities in the area of your planned excavation.

Whether it is as simple as planting a tree or building a fence, make the call.
