## **PLANNING AHEAD CAN REDUCE STRESS**

Expect slower cell/internet service and possible issues with debit/credit cards.

Grocery shopping early will allow stores time to restock while you avoid crowds.

Schedule appointments before or after the eclipse.

## **ANTICIPATE LOCAL IMPACTS**

Postpone lawn watering to reduce pressure on public water systems.

Expect longer lines at gas stations, retail stores and restaurants

There will be extra traffic - especially on the day of the eclipse.

## **PUBLIC HEALTH REMINDERS**

Have proper eye protection (ISO-certified glasses) when viewing the eclipse!

A food license is required if you plan to sell food from your home or business.
